- 1. **Welcome:** Eve extended a warm welcome to new members Julie and Jasmin Trafford. Kate reported that NLBS had 259 members at 09.07.2013, this figure includes those members who have yet to renew their 2013 subscription.

- 4. Matters Arising: None
- 5. Lady Reay, NLBS President: Lady Reay's husband, Hugh Mackay sadly passed away in May. A card and letter of condolence has been sent on behalf of the NLBS
- 6. **Slape Lane, Holme:** An improvement plan has been agreed. Burton Parish Council are in the process of applying for grants in an attempt to raise the necessary matched funding required by the County Council. NLBS have agreed to make a contribution of £1000 towards the Parish Councils efforts to raise these funds.
- 7. Trail Riders Fellowship (TRF): Local TRF members have provided support to NLBS in the past. They are an organization which represents responsible trail riders, working to preserve the rights of motorcyclists and others to use vehicular green lanes. Their aim is to preserve public rights of way for the benefit of ALL user groups. They are requesting our support in their fight against the closure of green lanes to mechanically propelled vehicles. In August 2011 The Peak District National Park made an Experimental Traffic Regulation Orders (ETRO) to prohibit mechanically propelled vehicles for 18 months from using Chapel Gate. Sue Clowes will write a letter in support as horse riders and horse drawn vehicles may be next.
- 8. **Tools:** It was agreed to obtain quotes for the purchase of tools to be used by group members for the clearing of bridleways.
