- 4. Chairperson's and Secretary's Annual Report: Another busy and successful year!

We had a variety of speakers and events over the year. They included:

An interesting talk by Sue Thompson on her experiences riding in Spain in July. An informative and entertaining presentation by Alison Whittaker-Stewart "From challenging mount to super steed" in September. Tack sale in October raised £650, a special mention of thanks to Chris Bell who organised the tack sale this year. In November, Vyv Wood Gee gave an excellent account of her Coast to Coast ride. Helen Wain helped us all with Map Reading in January. Christmas Meal was very successful. In March Jo MacRae from the Donkey Sanctuary gave a very interesting talk about the work of the Charity. Thank you Julie for organising all the speakers at our meetings. Members are asked to let Julie have any ideas for future speakers. 6 members attended an extremely interesting and informative BHS Access Training Day Part 2 in August delivered by Chris Peat, North West Regional Access and Bridleways Officer (RABO), about claiming bridleways and much more.

We are still waiting for Lancashire County Council to make a legal Order to revise the Definitive Map and mark the route through Thwaite Brow Woods and Mount Pleasant in Bolton le Sands as part- bridleway, part by-way and part-public road. It is in a queue in LCC's legal department. We are now targeting several routes for further research using a respected historian to assist us. Work is ongoing on this – many thanks in particular to Liz Davidson and Ailsa Gibson for taking this forward.

With many thanks to Sue Millard, we have streamlined and updated our website.

The group has been actively working on Bridleway Clearance and improvement, for example, in July, some volunteers cleared a bridleway at Greenlands Farm. This year, we have continued to improve bridleway gates and latches. Members are asked to let us know if there are any in their area that need attention.

After a request from the BHS, we compiled a list of places to ride on the beach in our area. This has also been added to our website.

We continue to advise riders to report any accidents or near misses to the BHS via their website. We organised a display at the British Thoroughbred Retraining Centre Open Day in August. We have supported a campaign by the BHS to make routes being developed for walking and cycling available for equestrian use. We made a link available on our website for members to write to their MP's about this. We have had encouraging responses from 4 MP's in the area. Three of our members met with a local councillor who also promised to support us in this. We have ordered some more 'Think Horse' signs.

Thanks to Liz Davidson who has pursued matters relating to the surface on the Bay Gateway Bridleway.

Many thanks to Julie Trafford who circulates our information via email and who looks after our Facebook page and Kay Edwards for taking the minutes of meetings. Our thanks go to Sheena Robertson for producing the newsletter, please let her have any photos, ride reports, horsey holiday ideas, in fact, anything you think might be of interest to members for the NLBS Newsletter.
